

2026 Building Trip Info Sheet for Portugal

Thank you for your interest in visiting Portugal with Volunteer Build to assist with converting an old workshop into 6 apartments for refugee families in Braga, Portugal. No prior building experience is required to participate in this trip and well-behaved children over 14 years old travelling with a parent are welcome.

A typical trip programme is attached for your information. The trip starts in Lisbon, Portugal, with a day to recover from jet lag, and visit some of the Lisbon tourist sites. We will then take a train to Porto where our in-country hosts will meet us to transfer us to Braga where we will be based for the week.

The trip finishes on Sunday 7th of June 2026. Team members have the option to join others in Morrocco for some R & R and tourism activities (additional cost from \$1,500 pp) for 11 days <u>prior</u> to the Portugal build trip.

Flights & Trip Budget:

Best available economy airfares from Auckland return are around \$3,000 to Lisbon. Different airlines (Singapore Airlines, Malaysia Airlines, Emirates, Qatar, China Eastern etc.) post sales at different times so you may get cheaper. Volunteers are responsible to organize their own flights to and from Lisbon. This trip is perfect if you already have European/UK travel already booked before or after our dates and want to take a week to build with us. If you are joining us on the optional Morrocco trip, you can either meet us in Casablanca, or travel from NZ with your Volunteer Build host.

Costs are based on an exchange rate of USO.55 to NZ\$1. Pricing is subject to change with movements in currency and supplier price changes.

Accommodation:

Share twin with same gender or your spouse/child in 3-star hotels and share twin in Braga guesthouse.

Transport: Hire vans with local drivers, Train

<u>Building Donation:</u> Each volunteer contributes NZ\$1,000 to the building fund on current exchange rate. A receipt will be provided which may qualify for up to a 33% (\$333) donation credit on your NZ tax.

<u>Vaccinations</u>: You will need to consult your doctor, however common vaccinations required are Tetanus, Diphtheria, MMR, Hepatitis A & B, flu vaccination. Remember it's not just you who needs protection – it's the Portuguese kids and families you interact with as

well. All team members must be vaccinated to travel on this tour and provide confirmation to us prior to departure. More information will be provided in the full pre-trip briefing.

<u>Visas</u>: For NZ passport (ensure expiry date is longer than 6 months after your return to NZ), no visas are required.

<u>Travel insurance</u> is compulsory and must include coverage for manual labor/building. Volunteer Build offers a Covermore policy. Once your application has been accepted, we will email you a quote.

Accommodation: Share twin with same gender or spouse.

Transport: Hire vans with local drivers, train, camel

<u>Vaccinations</u>: You will need to consult your doctor, however common vaccinations required are Tetanus, Diphtheria, MMR, Hepatitis A & B, typhoid, flu vaccination. Dogs infected with rabies are commonly found in Morocco. The CDC advises that if rabies exposures occur while in Morocco, rabies vaccines are typically available throughout most of the country.

<u>Visas</u>: For NZ passport (ensure expiry date is longer than 6 months after your return to NZ), no tourist visa is required.

<u>Travel insurance</u> is compulsory, and dates would be added to your Portugal build policy.
