
The Break Free Charitable Trust



2026 MEXICO Building Homes and Lives

In Mexico, we will spend 3 days building a home for a family in need in the colonias of Tijuana as well as participating in community outreach activities such as delivering personal care packs to a local prison, feeding the homeless or volunteering at a local school. At the end of the trip, team members have the option to extend their stay (at own cost) to fly to Cabo San Lucas or Cancun for some post build R & R and/or to assist another organisation with community outreach (food distribution, maintenance and beach cleanups).
